 - <u>Step 1</u>: Meet with a representative at an *Early Decision Presentation*, The representative will be on campus from 2nd to 5th period in Room 210 (students only need to attend *ONE* presentation during *ONE* class period).
 - Monday, December 12
 - Monday, January 9
 - Monday, January 23
 - <u>Step 2</u>: Fill out college application with the representative. The representative will be on campus from 2nd to 5th period in the Library Computer Lab (students only need to attend ONE workshop during ONE class period).
 - Monday, February 6
 - Monday, February 27
 - Social Security Number is required to complete the application (with the exception of AB540 students)
 - Application MUST be completed with a Citrus College Outreach representative (no exceptions)
 - Step 3: Early Decision Day Field Trip: Monday, April 10
 - Math & English assessment test and orientation
 - Explanation of scores by Counselors and Educational Advisors
 - Lunch will be provided
