 - Thursday, October 22
 - Thursday, November 5
 - Thursday, November 19
 - Thursday, December 3
 - Thursday, December 17
 - Thursday, January 21
 - <u>Step 2</u>: Application Workshop: Thurs, February 4 & 11 from 8 am to 12 pm in Room 120 (students only need to attend ONE presentation during ONE class period)
 - Social Security Number is required to complete the application
 - Application *must* be completed with a Citrus College Outreach representative (*no exceptions*)
 - Step 3: Early Decision Day Field Trip: Thurs, April 28
 - Math & English assessment test and orientation
 - Explanation of scores by Counselors and Educational Advisors
 - Students must bring their lunch
 - <u>Step 4</u>: Citrus Wrap-Up Presentation (optional): Thurs, May 26 during 3rd period in the Library
 - Next step instructions to help students complete the enrollment process
